**IN RE: HB4276** by Thompson, Ed (relating to the management of temporary tags that may be obtained by a motor vehicle dealer or converter.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to authorize the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TxDMV) by rule to establish the maximum number of temporary tags that a motor vehicle dealer or converter may obtain.

TxDMV indicates any costs or duties associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
