**IN RE: HB4294** by Metcalf (Relating to the organization and efficient operation of the legislative branch of state government through joint entities.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would clarify who is responsible for paying joint interim committee per diem and travel expenses and would authorize certain legislative agencies' governing boards to meet remotely during a disaster.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
