FISCAL NOTE, 87TH LEGISLATIVE REGULAR SESSION

IN RE: HJR99 by Canales (Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing a county to finance the development or redevelopment of transportation or infrastructure in unproductive, underdeveloped, or blighted areas in the county; authorizing the issuance of bonds and notes.), **As Passed 2nd House**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$178,333.

The joint resolution would propose a constitutional amendment authorizing a county to finance the development or redevelopment of transportation or infrastructure in unproductive, underdeveloped, or blighted areas in the county.

Local Government Impact

Taylor County anticipates no significant fiscal impact on the county. No significant fiscal implication to other units of local government is anticipated.
