**IN RE: HR2086 by Morales, Eddie (Suspending limitations on conference committee jurisdiction, H. B. No. 4305.), As Introduced**

The resolution would provide that the City of Brownsville would be entitled to receive state sales and use tax and state hotel tax revenue generated, paid, and collected by a qualified hotel and each restaurant, bar, and retail establishment located in or connected to the hotel. Entitlement to state tax revenue would be for a period of 10 years after the qualified hotel is open for initial occupancy. The fiscal implication of this provision cannot be estimated at this time.

**Local Government Impact**

The fiscal impact to the City of Brownsville cannot be estimated at this time.
