IN RE: SB62 by Zaffirini (Relating to permitting the Texas Ethics Commission to provide seminars and charge an attendance fee for those seminars.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Government Code to authorize the Texas Ethics Commission (TEC) to provide certain seminars and to charge a fee for those seminars in an amount necessary to cover associated costs.
