**IN RE: SB111** by West (Relating to certain duties of law enforcement agencies concerning certain information subject to disclosure to a defendant.), **Committee Report 2nd House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to certain duties of law enforcement agencies concerning certain information subject to disclosure to a defendant could be absorbed using existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

The Texas Association of Counties does not anticipate a significant fiscal impact to counties.

Houston Police Department estimates a cost of \$144,000 per year for additional staff to comply with the provisions of the bill.
