**IN RE: SB398** by Menéndez (Relating to distributed renewable generation resources.), **As Passed 2nd House**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The Public Utility Commission anticipates that the costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to distributed renewable generation resources could be absorbed using existing resources.

**Local Government Impact**

The PUC anticipates that this bill may have a local government impact as it includes provisions for municipalities and municipally-owned utilities. Those fiscal implications cannot be determined at this time.
