IN RE: SB626 by Zaffirini (Relating to guardianships, management trusts, and certain other procedures and proceedings for persons who are incapacitated, probate matters and proceedings, and other matters involving statutory county courts, including statutory probate courts.), **Conference Committee Report**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

Based on the analysis of the Office of Court Administration and the Health and Human Services Commission, it is assumed that duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the bill could be accomplished utilizing existing resources. In addition, no significant fiscal impact to the state court system is anticipated with the implementation of the bill.
