IN RE: SB739 by Birdwell (Relating to the presiding officers of the boards of directors of river authorities.), As Introduced

The bill would amend the Water Code to define the terms "Board" and "river authority" and would authorize the Governor to designate a member of the Board of certain river authorities to serve as a Presiding Officer. The bill would take effect September 1, 2021.
