IN RE: SB1054 by Huffman (Relating to mandatory conditions of community supervision, parole, or mandatory supervision concerning certain searches.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Code of Criminal Procedure and the Government Code as it relates to certain searches under community supervision, parole, and mandatory supervision.
