IN RE: SB1111 by Bettencourt (Relating to the residence address of a voter for purposes of a response to a confirmation notice sent by the voter registrar.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Election Code related to the residence address of a voter and would require the Secretary of State (SOS) adopt rules as necessary to implement certain provisions.

According to SOS, no significant fiscal impact is anticipated.
