IN RE: SB1132 by Johnson (Relating to the regulation of crafted precious metal dealers; authorizing the change of a fee.), **As Introduced**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner is a self-directed, semi-independent state entity and does not receive appropriated funds. The OCCC notes that there would be a cost of \$20,000 the first year, and \$12,000 every year afterwards. The OCCC would adjust fees to cover these costs.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
