IN RE: SB1138 by Hughes (Relating to a study on streamlining public safety net programs to reduce costs and improve outcomes for recipients under the programs.), **As Passed 2nd House**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Legislative Budget Board to conduct a study and prepare a report related to streamlining public safety net programs in the state of Texas.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.
