IN RE: SB1270 by Seliger (relating to the procurement of certain goods and services related to highways by the Texas Department of Transportation.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Transportation Code to give greater discretion to the Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to award certain contracts without a competitive bidding process.

According to the Comptroller of Public Accounts, the fiscal impact to the State cannot be estimated.

According to TxDOT, a positive fiscal impact that cannot be determined to TxDOT is anticipated.

Local Government Impact

According to TxDOT, no fiscal impact to units of local government is anticipated.
