**IN RE: SB1359** by Hughes (Relating to adoption by law enforcement agencies of a mental health leave policy for peace officers.), **As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

It is assumed that the costs associated with the bill's provisions relating to adoption by law enforcement agencies of a mental health leave policy for peace officers could be absorbed using existing resources.

This analysis assumes implementing the provisions of the bill would not result in a significant impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources.
