IN RE: SB1366 by Bettencourt (Relating to ad valorem tax sales of personal property seized under a tax warrant.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend Chapter 33 of the Tax Code, regarding property tax delinquency, to remove the county population limitation for counties that may have someone other than a peace officer advertise and conduct personal property auction tax sales, including online bidding and sale.
