IN RE: SB1911 by Blanco (Relating to the content of an application for Medicaid.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Chapter 32 of the Human Resources Code to change the content included on an application for medical assistance. This analysis assumes there would be a minimal cost associated with implementing the provisions of the bill that could be absorbed within current resources.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
