**IN RE: SB2232 by Hall (Relating to a study on the effect of a change to the period for voting.), As Engrossed**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would require the Secretary of State to conduct a study regarding the practical effects of eliminating the gap between the early voting period and election day.

The Secretary of State indicates it could absorb the costs associated with the bill within current resources.
