**IN RE: SJR47** by Huffman (Proposing a constitutional amendment changing the eligibility requirements for certain judicial offices.), **As Introduced**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated**, other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$178,333.

The joint resolution would propose an amendment to Article V of the Texas Constitution changing the eligibility requirements for certain judicial offices.

Adoption of the proposed constitutional amendment alone would have no fiscal impact on the state or units of local government other than the cost of publication.

The cost to the state for publication of the resolution is \$178,333.
