# CODIS - NDIS Statistics

## Measuring Success

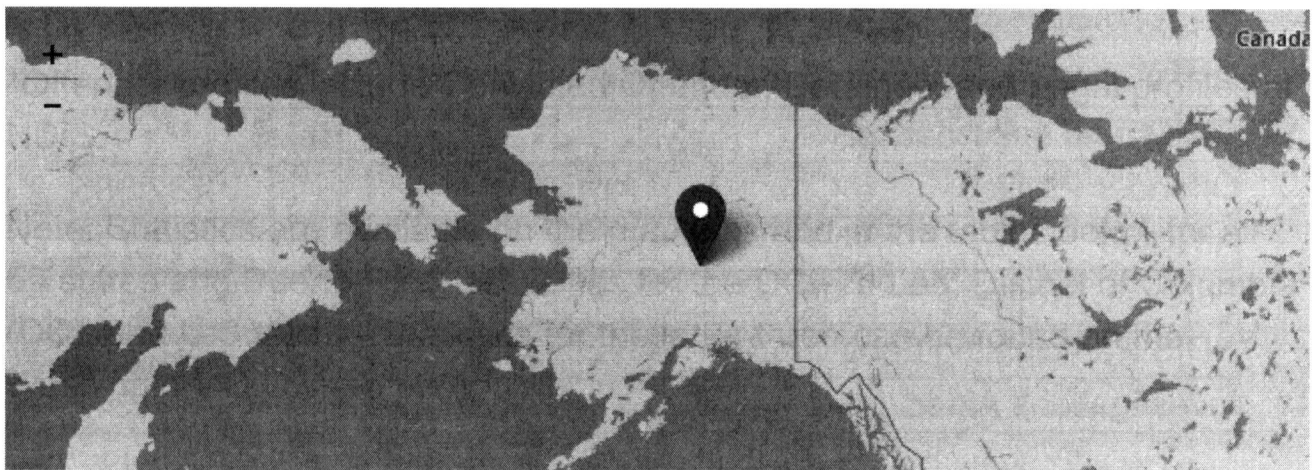
The National DNA Index (NDIS) contains over 14,430,404 offender<sup>1</sup> profiles, 4,239,300 arrestee profiles, and 1,082,436 forensic profiles as of January 2021. Ultimately, the success of the CODIS program will be measured by the crimes it helps to solve. CODIS's primary metric, the "Investigation Aided," tracks the number of criminal investigations where CODIS has added value to the investigative process. As of January 2021, CODIS has produced over 548,757 hits assisting in more than 535,822 investigations.
