

**NOTICE OF INTENT
TO INTRODUCE A BILL**

Pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas, notice is hereby given of the intention to apply to the 87th Legislature of the State of Texas at its Regular Session in Austin, Texas for the introduction of a Bill, the substance of the contemplated law being as follows:

An Act relating to the special purpose territory of the Port of Beaumont Navigation District of Jefferson County, Texas. The costs for the publication of this Notice were paid by D. Chris Fisher, Port Director & CEO, on behalf of the Port of Beaumont Navigation District of Jefferson County, Texas. The Act will provide as follows:

Section 1. Sec. 5010.0104 of the Special District Local Laws Code, is amended to add Subsection 5010.0104(2), as to the special purpose territory of the District.

Section 2. Chapter 5010, Sub-Chapter F, Special District Local Laws Code, is added to specify as follows:

Sec. 5010.0601. DEFINITION. Special Purpose Area.

Sec. 5010.0602. REPORTING OF CARGO AND VESSEL MOVEMENTS.

Sec. 5010.0603. EFFECT ON OTHER DISTRICTS.

Sec. 5010.0604. TAXATION PROHIBITED.

Section 3. Specifies the special purpose area of the District.

Section 4. Provides for legal notice of the intention to introduce the Act as set forth herein and notes certain persons, agencies, officials or entities which are required to be furnished notice and copy of the Act under §59, Article XI, Texas Constitution and Chapter 313, Government Code.

Section 5. States, if adopted, the Act takes effect on September 1, 2021.

Port of Beaumont Navigation District of Jefferson County, Texas is located with the City of Beaumont, Texas and adjacent unincorporated areas within Jefferson County, Texas. All interested persons will, therefore, take notice of the matters and facts set out in the foregoing statement of the substance of the contemplated laws as required by the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas.
