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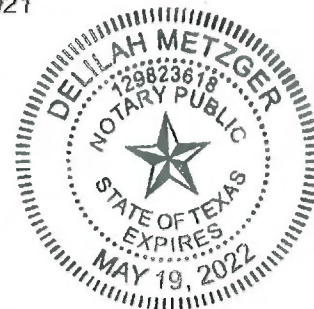

Notice is hereby given of the intention to introduce in the Regular Session of the 87th Legislature of Texas a bill creating and establishing a special district consisting of approximately 120 acres and located within the John Jones Survey, Abstract No. 481, within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of Houston, Texas, and wholly within Harris County, Texas, to be known as Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 579, under the provisions of Article 16, Section 59 of the Constitution of Texas and pursuant to the inherent power of the Legislature to create special governmental agencies and districts, with powers including those given to municipal utility districts operating pursuant to Chapters 49 and 54, Texas Water Code, and including road powers under Article III, Section 52 of the Constitution of Texas.
