HB 6 Cain | et al.
Relating to election integrity and preservation of the purity of the ballot box through the prevention of fraud in the conduct of an election; increasing criminal penalties; creating criminal offenses.

HB 1300 Guillen
Relating to the reading and marking of a ballot by a person occupying a voting station or by the person's child.

HB 2092 Sanford
Relating to a requirement that candidates for municipal elective office declare a party affiliation.

HB 3269 Noble
Relating to the requirement that a ballot to be voted by mail be canceled and returned before voting in person.

HB 1987 Vasut
Relating to eligibility requirements to hold a political party office.
