HB 273 Canales | et al.
Relating to the establishment of a pilot program for the issuance of digital identification.

HB 368 Sherman, Sr.
Relating to the issuance of a driver's license to a state legislator or prosecutor that includes an alternative to the license holder's residence address.

HB 882 Hinojosa | et al.
Relating to the unlawful transfer of a firearm; creating a criminal offense.

HB 911 Patterson | et al. Posting Rule Suspended
Relating to the issuance of specially marked driver's licenses and personal identification certificates to veterans.

HB 1119 Lucio III
Relating to the establishment of the Texas Uninsured Vehicle Enforcement Program.

HB 1157 Vo
Relating to hiring and licensing certain veterans as peace officers.

HB 1379 Patterson | et al. Posting Rule Suspended
Relating to required notice prohibiting firearms at certain businesses selling or serving alcoholic beverages and the prohibition on carrying certain weapons on those premises.

HB 1400 Swanson | et al.
Relating to the creation of the criminal offense of impersonating a private investigator.

HB 1513 Zwiener
Relating to law enforcement policies prohibiting a peace officer from using less lethal projectiles for the purpose of controlling the activity or movement of a gathering of people.

HB 1938 Jetton | et al.
Relating to a grant program for law enforcement agencies to defray the cost of data storage for recordings created with body worn cameras.

HB 2214 Hefner
Relating to the expiration of a school marshal license issued or renewed by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement.

HB 2281 Hefner
Relating to the prosecution of the offense of possessing a weapon in certain prohibited places associated with schools or postsecondary educational institutions.

HB 2302 White
Relating to the creation of the criminal offense of a peace officer making a false statement in an incident report.

HB 2349 Noble | et al.
Relating to vehicle safety inspections of certain travel trailers.

HB 2618 Hernandez
Relating to the exception to disclosure under the public information law of certain personal information contained in a citation issued for a violation of a state traffic law or local traffic ordinance.

HB 2886 Clardy
Relating to the designation of a company representative for purposes of compliance with the Private Security Act.

HB 3017 Wu
Relating to criminal liability for reporting false information to draw an emergency response; creating an offense.

HB 3075 Coleman
Relating to the collection and reporting of certain information regarding mental health jail diversion.

HB 3251 Thompson, Ed Posting Rule Suspended
Relating to the use of unmanned aircraft.
