HB 209 Thierry
Relating to a franchise tax credit for entities that establish a grocery store or healthy corner store in a food desert.

HB 1197 Metcalf
Relating to the period for which certain land owned by a religious organization for the purpose of expanding a place of religious worship or constructing a new place of religious worship may be exempted from ad valorem taxation.

HB 1391 Middleton
Relating to the effect of an election at which the voters fail to approve or vote to reduce the ad valorem tax rate adopted by the governing body of a taxing unit.

HB 1869 Burrows
Relating to the definition of debt for the purposes of calculating certain ad valorem tax rates of a taxing unit.

HB 2014 Lucio III
Relating to ad valorem taxation.

HB 2080 Leman | et al.
Relating to taxpayers' suits.

HB 2398 Meyer
Relating to the administration and collection of sales and use taxes and certain fees applicable to sales involving marketplace providers.

HB 2404 Meyer
Relating to the creation and maintenance of a database of information regarding certain local economic development agreements; providing a civil penalty.

HB 2429 Meyer
Relating to the alternate provisions for ad valorem tax rate notices when the de minimis rate of a taxing unit exceeds the voter-approval tax rate.

HB 2510 Noble | et al.
Relating to a sales and use tax exemption for animals adopted from or sold by nonprofit animal welfare organizations.

HB 2625 Noble
Relating to excluding the furnishing of an academic transcript from the definition of "information service" for purposes of sales and use taxes.
