Relating to insurer restrictions and duties regarding repair of a motor vehicle covered under an insurance policy.

**SB 1541** Zaffirini

Relating to the definition of business case for major information resources projects.

**SB 1606** Hall | et al.

Relating to protecting the population of Texas, its environment, and its most vulnerable communities, promoting the resilience of the electric grid and certain municipalities.

**SB 1783** Creighton

Relating to a fee collected by a landlord in lieu of a security deposit.

**SB 1988** Miles

Relating to liability of certain electric utilities that allow certain uses of land that the electric utility owns, occupies, or leases.

**SB 2122** Hughes

Relating to itemized billing for health care services and supplies provided by health care providers.

**SB 2124** Blanco

Relating to the authority of a health benefit plan sponsor to consent to electronic delivery of certain communications on behalf of a party enrolled in the plan.
