To protect the health and safety of members, staff and the public, the Senate Finance Committee (SFC) will strictly follow all Senate rules relating to the pandemic, including the requirement for a negative COVID test to enter the hearing room.

Anyone wishing to provide oral public testimony must register in E1.028 by **noon or upon recess of the Committee hearing**, whichever may come first. Oral testimony is limited to 3 minutes. If providing written testimony, bring **20 copies, with your name on each copy**, to E1.028. All written testimony will be distributed to the Committee Members after the hearing. Those registering a position-only may do so at any Senate kiosk by the end of the hearing.

- **Oral testimony:** fill out a paper witness card in E1.028 and submit to SFC staff.
- **Oral and written testimony:** fill out a paper witness card in E1.028 and submit your witness card and written testimony to SFC staff.
- **Position only:** register using the Senate kiosk located in the extension hallways or by going to <http://swrs> on public-capitol. Kiosk registration will open 30 minutes before the hearing begins.
- **Written testimony only:** register your position using the Senate kiosk and then bring **20 copies, with your name on each copy**, to E1.028 and submit to SFC staff.

The afternoon hearing will reconvene after the Senate adjourns when in session.
