- **Oral testimony:** fill out a paper witness card at the registration table outside the hearing room, E1.036, and submit to SFC staff.
- **Oral and written testimony:** fill out a paper witness card at the registration table outside the hearing room, E1.036 and submit your witness card and written testimony to SFC staff.
- **Position only:** register using the Senate kiosk located in the extension hallways or by going to <http://swrs> on public-capitol.
- **Written testimony only:** register your position using the Senate kiosk and then bring 40 copies, with your name on each copy, to the registration table outside the hearing room, E1.036 and submit to SFC staff.
