· Oral testimony: fill out a paper witness card at the table in front of E1.028 before the hearing.

· Oral and written testimony: fill out a paper witness card in the E1.028 and submit your witness card and written testimony to LGC staff.

· Position only: register using the Senate kiosk located in the extension hallways or by going to <http://swrs> on public-capitol. Kiosk registration will open at 9 a.m. the morning of the hearing.

· Written testimony only: register your position using the Senate kiosk and then bring 20 copies, with your name on each copy, to the Extension Auditorium and submit to LGC staff.
