Relating to the marketing and sale of catfish and similar fish by food service establishments; providing administrative and civil penalties.

HB 1631 Guerra | et al. SP: Hughes
Relating to the requirements for an application for a permit to manage wildlife and exotic animals from aircraft; authorizing a fee.

HB 2095 Wilson SP: Perry
Relating to water research conducted by The University of Texas Bureau of Economic Geology.

HB 2710 Bowers SP: Zaffirini
Relating to an exemption to the cancellation of a water right for nonuse.

HB 2850 Kacal | et al. SP: Springer
Relating to the liability of certain volunteers who provide veterinary care or treatment and certain confidential or privileged information related to veterinary care or treatment.

Relating to the creation of the Trinity Bay Special Utility District and the powers and duties of the Trinity Bay Conservation District; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose assessments or fees.

HB 3081 Krause | et al. SP: Springer
Relating to the issuance of digital tags for the taking of certain animals.

HB 3289 González, Mary SP: Blanco
Relating to the penalties for a violation of a quarantine or rule to protect pecans or pecan trees from diseases or pests; increasing civil penalties.

HB 3568 Kacal SP: Kolkhorst

Relating to the sale and purchase of certain fish.

HB 3750 Lucio III | et al. SP: Lucio

Relating to financial assistance by the Texas Water Development Board for backup power generators in economically distressed areas for public water supply and sanitary sewer systems.

HB 3802 Lozano | et al. SP: Zaffirini

Relating to requirements for public drinking water supply systems and certain rates and fees charged by water supply corporations.

HB 3959 Buckley | et al. SP: Perry

Relating to the establishment of the Texas youth livestock show grant program.

HB 4650 Rodriguez SP: Zaffirini

Relating to the creation of the East Central Travis County Conservation and Reclamation District No. 1; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose assessments, fees, and taxes.
