A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to requiring a school district to post the district's
3 employment policy on the district's Internet website.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 11.1513, Education Code, is amended by
6 adding Subsection (k) to read as follows:

7 (k) A school district shall post on the district's Internet
8 website, if the district has a website, the employment policy
9 adopted by the district's board of trustees under Subsection (a)
10 and the full text of any regulations or forms referenced in the
11 policy.

12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.

4 (1) On page 1, line 29, strike "or forms".

5 (2) On page 1, line 30, immediately following the underlined
6 period, insert the following:

7 A school district shall make available any forms referenced in the
8 policy:

9 (1) on an intranet website that is maintained by the
10 district and accessible to district employees; or

11 (2) if the district does not maintain an intranet
12 website described by Subdivision (1), at a district administrative
13 office designated by the district.
