1 AN ACT  
2 relating to an exemption for certain cemeteries from cemetery  
3 location restrictions.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 711.008, Health and Safety Code, is  
6 amended by adding Subsection (1) to read as follows:

7 (1) Subsection (a) does not apply to a cemetery established  
8 and operating before September 1, 2021, in a municipality:

9 (1) with a population of not less than 75,000 and not  
10 more than 95,000; and

11 (2) in which a state veterans cemetery is located.

12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2021.
