## A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment excepting certain 2 appropriations to pay for school district ad valorem tax relief 3 from the constitutional limitation on the rate of growth of 4 appropriations.

5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 22, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is 7 amended by adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:

8 <u>(a-1) Appropriations from state tax revenues not dedicated</u> 9 <u>by this constitution that are made for the purpose of paying for</u> 10 <u>school district ad valorem tax relief as identified by the</u> 11 <u>legislature by general law are not included as appropriations for</u> 12 <u>purposes of determining whether the rate of growth of</u> 13 <u>appropriations exceeds the limitation prescribed by Subsection (a)</u> 14 of this <u>section.</u>

15 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to 16 the Texas Constitution:

17 <u>TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies</u> 18 <u>to the amendment to Section 22, Article VIII, of this constitution</u> 19 <u>as proposed by the 88th Legislature, 2nd Called Session, 2023,</u> 20 <u>excepting certain appropriations to pay for school district ad</u> 21 <u>valorem tax relief from the constitutional limitation on the rate</u> 22 <u>of growth of appropriations.</u>

(b) The change made to Section 22, Article VIII, of this
constitution by the amendment applies to appropriations made for

1 <u>the state fiscal biennium beginning September 1, 2023, and</u> 2 <u>subsequent state fiscal bienniums.</u>

3 (c) This temporary provision expires September 1, 2025.

4 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 5 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2023. 6 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the 7 proposition: "The constitutional amendment excepting certain 8 appropriations to pay for school district property tax relief from 9 the constitutional limitation on the rate of growth of 10 appropriations."
