Dutton, Jr., in 2012 and rose to become chief of staff; she continued her education as well, 10 11 earning her law degree magna cum laude from Texas Southern 12 University in 2018; and

13 WHEREAS, Ms. Jones demonstrated exceptional skill and 14 dedication as a committee clerk during multiple sessions, furthering the work of the House Committees on Urban Affairs, 15 Public Education, and Juvenile Justice and Family Issues; a 16 stalwart champion of education and literacy, she brought her 17 18 characteristic enthusiasm and persistence to bear in supporting legislation to improve reading scores and effect meaningful change 19 in other key areas; moreover, she was committed to addressing 20 21 racial disparities in education outcomes and ensuring fairness in 22 rules for charter schools; in tribute to her exceptional efforts, 23 the TSU Thurgood Marshall School of Law is establishing a 24 scholarship in her honor; and
