## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to making an appropriation for the construction,
- 3 operation, and maintenance of border barrier infrastructure.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION TO TRUSTEED PROGRAMS WITHIN THE
- 6 OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR. (a) The amount of \$1,500,000,000 is
- 7 appropriated from the general revenue fund to the Trusteed Programs
- 8 within the Office of the Governor for use during the two-year period
- 9 beginning on the effective date of this Act for the construction,
- 10 operation, and maintenance of border barrier infrastructure.
- 11 (b) The Trusteed Programs within the Office of the Governor
- 12 may not contract with any known antisemitic, white supremacist, or
- 13 other known hate group to construct, operate, or maintain border
- 14 barrier infrastructure for which money is appropriated under
- 15 Subsection (a) of this section.
- 16 SECTION 2. PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF FUNDS. The money
- 17 appropriated by this Act may not be used to:
- 18 (a) acquire property through the exercise of eminent
- 19 domain;
- 20 (b) build a barrier along this state's international border
- 21 with Mexico on property acquired through the exercise of eminent
- 22 domain;
- 23 (c) acquire property for a barrier that abuts the
- 24 jurisdictional boundary between this state and another U.S. state;

- 2 (d) build a barrier that abuts the jurisdictional boundary
- 3 between this state and another U.S. state.
- 4 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 5 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 6 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 7 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 8 immediate effect, this Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 9 last day of the legislative session.
