## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the provision of certain behavioral health services,
3	including intensive outpatient services and partial
4	hospitalization services, under Medicaid.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 533.00255(a), Government Code, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	(a) In this section <u>:</u>
9	(1) "Behavioral [, "behavioral] health services"
10	means mental health and substance $\underline{\text{use}}$ [ $\frac{\text{abuse}}{\text{absorder services}}$ .
11	The term includes intensive outpatient services and partial
12	hospitalization services.
13	(2) "Intensive outpatient services" means outpatient
14	treatment services, including treatment services for substance use
15	disorders, depression, eating disorders, and other mental health
16	conditions that do not require detoxification or 24-hour
17	supervision, provided to patients who require a time-limited,
18	multifaceted array of services, structures, and supports by a team
19	of clinical staff capable of providing, at a minimum, the following
20	services:
21	(A) individual counseling;
22	(B) group counseling;
23	(C) family counseling;
24	(D) motivational enhancement training; and

- 1 (E) relapse prevention, drug refusal, and coping
- 2 skills training.
- 3 (3) "Partial hospitalization services" means distinct
- 4 and organized intensive ambulatory treatment services provided for
- 5 periods of not more than 24 hours at a location other than a
- 6 patient's home or in an inpatient or a residential care setting.
- 7 The term includes the services described by 42 C.F.R. Section
- 8 410.43(a)(4).
- 9 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 10 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 11 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 12 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 13 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 14 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 16 last day of the legislative session.
