A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the administration of the University Interscholastic
3	League.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 33, Education Code, is amended by adding
6	Subchapter D-1 to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER D-1. UNIVERSITY INTERSCHOLASTIC LEAGUE ADMINISTRATION
8	Sec. 33.121. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
9	(1) "League" means the University Interscholastic
10	League.
11	(2) "Legislative council" means the governing body of
12	the league that proposes, implements, and administers rules and
13	procedures for the league as provided by this chapter.
14	Sec. 33.122. ADMINISTRATION OF LEAGUE. (a) The
15	legislative council shall amend the league's constitution and
16	contest rules as necessary to comply with this subchapter and
17	submit the proposed amended constitution and rules to the
18	commissioner for approval. The commissioner may not approve a
19	provision of the proposed constitution or a rule submitted by the
20	league that conflicts with the requirements of this subchapter.
21	(b) The league shall require:
22	(1) an interpretation of a contest rule proposed by
23	the league and approved by the commissioner to:
24	(A) be in writing and specify the relevant rule

- 1 and the date of the interpretation; and
- 2 (B) be made available on the league's Internet
- 3 website not later than 24 hours after the interpretation is
- 4 produced; and
- 5 (2) the legislative council to propose amendments to
- 6 the league's constitution and contest rules annually.
- 7 Sec. 33.123. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. The executive director of
- 8 the league may not serve more than one four-year term.
- 9 <u>Sec. 33.124. TERM OF OFFICE. A member of the state</u>
- 10 executive committee of the league may not serve more than two
- 11 two-year terms.
- 12 Sec. 33.125. REQUIRED TRAINING. Each member of a district
- 13 executive committee and the state executive committee of the league
- 14 must complete a training course:
- 15 (1) under Section 551.005, Government Code; and
- 16 (2) regarding the conduct of a fair and impartial
- 17 hearing.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 19 last day of the legislative session.
