A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

| 4 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 5 | SECTION 1. Section 154.001, Education Code, is amended to |
| 6 | read as follows: |
| 7 | Sec. 154.001. <u>DEFINITIONS</u> [DEFINITION]. In this chapter: |
| 8 | (1) "Advisory committee" means the Neurodegenerative |
| 9 | Disease Advisory Committee. |
| 10 | (2) "Council [, "council]" means the Texas Council on |
| 11 | Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders. |
| 12 | SECTION 2. Chapter 154, Education Code, is amended by |
| 13 | adding Section 154.0045 to read as follows: |
| 14 | Sec. 154.0045. NEURODEGENERATIVE DISEASE ADVISORY |
| 15 | COMMITTEE. (a) The council shall establish the Neurodegenerative |
| 16 | Disease Advisory Committee to: |
| 17 | (1) support the consortium of Alzheimer's disease |
| 18 | centers through the council's Darrell K Royal Texas Alzheimer's |
| 19 | <pre>Initiative in:</pre> |
| 20 | (A) discovering the causes of Alzheimer's |
| 21 | disease and other neurodegenerative diseases in humans; |
| 22 | (B) developing cures for those diseases; and |
| 23 | (C) establishing programs to address access to |
| 24 | advanced treatment of Alzheimer's disease; and |

- 1 (2) establish appropriate standards consistent with
- 2 the powers and duties of the consortium under this chapter to ensure
- 3 the proper use of money authorized for Alzheimer's disease
- 4 research, facilities development, and caregiver resources.
- 5 (b) The advisory committee is composed of the following nine
- 6 members:
- 7 (1) one member appointed by the governor who is a
- 8 <u>member of</u> the Board of Advisors for the Darrell K Royal Research
- 9 Fund for Alzheimer's Disease;
- 10 (2) four members appointed by the lieutenant governor;
- 11 and
- 12 (3) four members appointed by the speaker of the house
- 13 of representatives.
- 14 (c) In appointing members to the advisory committee under
- 15 <u>Subsections (b)(2) and (3), the lieutenant governor and the speaker</u>
- 16 of the house of representatives must each appoint:
- 17 (1) three individuals who are physicians or scientists
- 18 with extensive experience in the field of Alzheimer's disease and
- 19 neurology, including at least one individual who represents a
- 20 nationally designated Alzheimer's disease research center funded
- 21 by the National Institute on Aging; and
- 22 (2) one member of the public.
- 23 (d) The member appointed by the governor under Subsection
- 24 (b)(1) serves as chair of the advisory committee.
- 25 (e) The members of the advisory committee serve staggered
- 26 three-year terms. The appointing authorities shall appoint the
- 27 initial member to terms of one, two, and three years as necessary to

- 1 ensure one-third of the appointed members' terms expire each year.
- 2 <u>(f) The members of the advisory committee serve at the</u>
- 3 pleasure of the appointing authority.
- 4 (g) If a vacancy occurs on the advisory committee, the
- 5 appropriate appointing authority shall appoint a successor in the
- 6 same manner as the original appointment to serve for the remainder
- 7 of the unexpired term. The appropriate appointing authority shall
- 8 appoint the successor not later than the 30th day after the date the
- 9 vacancy occurs.
- 10 (h) The council shall hire personnel as necessary to support
- 11 the advisory committee in fulfilling its duties under this chapter.
- 12 (i) Section 2110.008, Government Code, does not apply to the
- 13 advisory committee.
- SECTION 3. Not later than March 1, 2024, the governor,
- 15 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives
- 16 shall appoint members of the Neurodegenerative Disease Advisory
- 17 Committee established under Section 154.0045, Education Code, as
- 18 added by this Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 20 last day of the legislative session.
