- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 418.012, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 418.012. EXECUTIVE ORDERS. (a) Under this chapter,
- 9 the governor may issue executive orders, proclamations, and
- 10 regulations and amend or rescind them. Executive orders,
- 11 proclamations, and regulations have the force and effect of law.
- 12 (b) An executive order, proclamation, or regulation issued
- 13 by the governor under this chapter during a pandemic that restricts
- 14 the operation of or the hours of operation for a business that sells
- 15 alcoholic beverages may not include an organization exempt from
- 16 federal taxation under Section 501(a), Internal Revenue Code of
- 17 1986, as an organization described by Section 501(c)(19) of that
- 18 code, that benefits veterans of the United States armed forces.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 418.012, Government Code, as amended by
- 20 this Act, applies only to a declaration of a state of disaster
- 21 issued or renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 22 declaration issued before the effective date of this Act is
- 23 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 24 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
