5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Education Code, is

7	Sec. 21.0521. TEMPORARY CERTIFICATION OF EDUCATORS FROM
8	OUTSIDE THIS STATE. (a) The board shall:
9	(1) establish a temporary educator certificate for
10	educators certified by other states; and
11	(2) immediately issue a certificate described by
12	Subdivision (1) to a person who applies for a certificate issued
13	under Section 21.052.
14	(b) The board may rescind a temporary educator certificate
15	issued to a person under this section if the hoard determines as a

- (c) To be eligible for a temporary educator certificate 18
- 19 issued under this section, a person must:
- (1) hold a valid, unexpired, non-temporary 20

- the person to be employed as an educator in that state; and 22
- 23 (2) hold a bachelor's degree from an institution of
- 24 higher education that is, and at the time the person received the

- 2 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), a temporary
- 3 educator certificate issued under this section expires on the

- 5 (1) the first anniversary of the date the certificate

- 7 (2) the date the person is issued a certificate under
- 8 Section 21.052.
- 9 (e) A temporary educator certificate issued under this
- 10 section to an educator who is the spouse of a person serving on
- 11 active duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States, as
- 12 those terms are defined by Section 55.001, Occupations Code,
- 13 expires on the third anniversary of the date the certificate is
- 14 issued or a later date specified by board rule.
- 15 (f) A temporary educator certificate issued under this
- 16 section may not be reissued or renewed.
- SECTION 2. Sections 21.052(c), (d), (d-1), (e), and (i)(1)
- 18 and (2), Education Code, are repealed.
- 19 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 20 of this Act, the State Board for Educator Certification shall adopt
- 21 rules necessary to implement Section 21.0521, Education Code, as
- 22 added by this Act.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
