- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 33.023 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 33.023. ACCESS TO SCHOOL LIBRARY MATERIALS BY
- 8 NON-ENROLLED STUDENT. (a) In this section, "non-enrolled student"
- 9 means a student who receives instruction as described by Section
- 10 29.916(a)(1) from a nonpublic school.
- 11 (b) The board of trustees of a school district and the
- 12 governing body of an open-enrollment charter school shall adopt a
- 13 policy allowing a non-enrolled student who resides in the district
- 14 or in the geographic area served by the school to access the
- 15 district's or school's library materials in the same manner that the
- 16 district or school provides access to students enrolled in the
- 17 district or school.

- 18 <u>(c) A policy adopted under Subsection (b) must require a</u>
- 19 <u>non-enrolled student who seeks access to a school district's or</u>
- 20 open-enrollment charter school's library materials to establish
- 21 minimum proof of residency.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 3 legislative session.
