4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 33.2055 to read as follows:

- 7 Sec. 33.2055. HEAT STRESS SAFETY POLICY REQUIRED FOR OUTDOOR ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES. (a) A school district or 8 open-enrollment charter school that offers an extracurricular 9 athletic activity that includes outdoor practices or competitions 10 shall adopt a heat stress safety policy for outdoor athletic 11 12 activities to protect student athletes from heat-related injury. The policy must include criteria for taking appropriate protective 13 14 measures based on the wet-bulb globe temperature at the location of the activity. 15
- 16 (b) Any organization, company, or other entity using a

 17 school district or open-enrollment charter school facility for an

 18 outdoor athletic activity shall comply with the district's or

 19 school's policy adopted under Subsection (a).
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the 21 last day of the legislative session.
