CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1           WHEREAS, God keeps His promises, and the Lord your God is God  
2 and is faithful to keep His promises for all time to come; and

3           WHEREAS, The promises of God are stated thusly in the Gospel  
4 of John: "And I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish;  
5 neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand"; and

6           WHEREAS, God has given to us His great and precious promises  
7 of love, hope, joy, peace, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,  
8 wisdom, and strength to sustain us through the life He has given us;  
9 and

10           WHEREAS, God gives power to the weak, and to those who have no  
11 might, He increases strength; and

12           WHEREAS, Be strong and courageous; do not be afraid because  
13 of them, for the Lord your God goes with you; He will never leave you  
14 nor forsake you; and

15           WHEREAS, The promise of God is His word, which is revelation

7 [391.004](#)(d), Government Code, this designation remain in effect  
8 until the 10th anniversary of the date this resolution is finally  
9 passed by the legislature.
