1 WHEREAS, Falls City Elementary School has been named a 2023
2 National Blue Ribbon School, one of the most prestigious
3 designations an elementary or secondary school in the United States
4 can receive; and

5 WHEREAS, The National Blue Ribbon Schools Program was created
6 by the U.S. Department of Education in 1982 to recognize campuses
7 that have demonstrated superior academic performance or made
8 notable progress in improving outcomes among economically
9 disadvantaged students; Falls City Elementary was one of only 353
10 public and private schools nationwide and 29 schools in Texas to
11 have earned this impressive honor in 2023; and

12 WHEREAS, Under the able leadership of principal Jessica Luna,
13 Falls City Elementary serves approximately 250 students in
14 prekindergarten through sixth grade; its faculty places an emphasis
15 on differentiating instruction to meet the individual needs of each
16 student, and as a result of intentional student and staff
17 engagement, the school has seen significant academic and leadership
18 achievement; it was recently honored with an A accountability
19 rating from the Texas Education Agency in 2022; and

20 WHEREAS, Through hard work and perseverance, the teachers and
21 students of Falls City Elementary have established a record of
22 scholastic excellence, and their outstanding efforts have been duly
23 recognized with the Blue Ribbon School award; now, therefore, be it
