- 4 WHEREAS, An interdisciplinary ethnic studies program within
- 5 the College of Liberal Arts, CMAS was authorized by the 73rd Texas
- 6 Legislature in 1993; State Representative Roberto Alonzo, the first
- 7 Mexican American elected to the legislature from North Texas,
- 8 played a key role in the drive to create the center, which formally
- 9 opened on October 12, 1994, under founding director José Ángel
- 10 Gutiérrez; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The center promotes research and the recruitment,
- 12 retention, and professional development of UTA faculty actively
- 13 engaged in studies on Latino issues; students can pursue an 18-hour
- 14 academic minor in Mexican American and Latina/o Studies, with
- 15 classes on literature, history, and politics; CMAS offers
- 16 scholarships for students as well as funding for faculty members
- 17 studying related subjects; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Engaging the wider UTA community, the center
- 19 sponsors events in both Spanish and English, such as career
- 20 workshops and speaker series; among undergraduate students at UTA,
- 21 36 percent identify as Latino, and CMAS helps to ensure that their
- 22 experiences are reflected and their needs for representation are
- 23 met; and
- 24 WHEREAS, The university's mariachi group, Mariachi Los

- 1 Jinetes, found support through the center when it was established,
- 2 and CMAS hires the group to perform for occasions throughout the
- 3 year; serving as a bridge between UTA and the Latino community in
- 4 the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex, the center hosts a variety of
- 5 service outreach activities; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Since its inception, CMAS has advanced knowledge,
- 7 understanding, and appreciation of Latino heritage and
- 8 contributions, equipping Texans to participate more fully in our
- 9 diverse society and advance more successfully in an increasingly
