

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Dr. John Redman of Chambers Health has set an
2 inspiring example by participating in nine medical mission trips to
3 five different countries; and

4 WHEREAS, A board-certified physician, Dr. Redman practices
5 family and emergency medicine at Chambers Health, where he serves
6 patients in the Anahuac area; beyond the scope of his work at the
7 clinic, he has traveled to Mexico, Honduras, Nicaragua, Ecuador,
8 and Moldova to provide medical care to people in need; and

9 WHEREAS, Last September, Dr. Redman was part of a team with
10 Global Health Outreach, a short-term international missions
11 program that visited Nicaragua for a week to perform a variety of
12 health care services for underserved residents; the team treated
13 approximately 900 patients of all ages, to whom they provided
14 medical and dental care, medications, and even reading glasses at
15 no cost; members of the group even ventured into the mountains to
16 deliver medications and a walker to a patient who was unable to
17 travel to their temporary clinic; and

18 WHEREAS, By sharing his time and expertise to serve people
19 across the globe, Dr. John Redman has demonstrated the strength of
20 his commitment to helping others, and he is truly deserving of
21 special recognition; now, therefore, be it

24 taking part in overseas medical mission trips and extend to him
