9 WHEREAS, A lifelong resident of San Marcos, Ms. Earls has dedicated herself to improving the overall quality of life in the 10 11 community and to helping those in need through her extensive 12 volunteer efforts; she has given generously of her time and talents to a number of groups, including the Bluebonnet Lions Club, the Hays 13 County Crime Stoppers board of directors, and the City of San Marcos 14 Human Services Advisory Board, and as the first African American 15 16 president of the League of Women Voters of Hays County, she advocated for voters' rights, endorsed scholarships that were 17 awarded to students with disabilities, and worked tirelessly to 18 ensure that citizens were educated on the importance of voting and 19 20 civic engagement; and

21 WHEREAS, Ms. Earls has also provided invaluable support to 22 numerous children as a court appointed special advocate, and she 23 has further benefited area youth through her service on the 24 Nosotros La Gente board of directors; moreover, she has encouraged
