2 Christi suffered an immeasurable loss with his death on August 13,
3 2023, at the age of 29; and

4 WHEREAS, Born in Corpus Christi on December 3, 1993, Cody
5 Perez was the son of Cynthia Perez; he was raised with the help of
6 his mother's family and later formed a relationship with his
7 brother, Fermin; passionate about baseball from an early age, he
8 played shortstop for the Trojans at Foy H. Moody High School, and he
9 graduated 10th in his class in 2012; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Perez went on to attend New Mexico Junior
11 College on a full baseball scholarship, and he continued his
12 baseball career and education at Coastal Bend College, earning an
13 Associate of Science degree in Kinesiology; at Texas A&M
14 International University, he was a member of the Dustdevils
15 baseball team and received a Bachelor of Science degree in
16 Kinesiology with a minor in Biology; and

17 WHEREAS, In 2016, Mr. Perez embarked on a career in education
18 at Bishop High School; a gifted mentor, he excelled in teaching
19 Biology, Anatomy and Physiology, and in coaching football and
20 baseball; along the way, he earned a Master's degree in Educational
21 Leadership and Policy Studies from The University of Texas at
22 Arlington, and he also began working toward his Administrative
23 certification; and

24 WHEREAS, Beloved for his smile and his sense of humor,

1 Mr. Perez enjoyed engaging in friendly competition; he was an avid
2 supporter of the New York Yankees and the Dallas Cowboys, and he was
3 devoted to his Labradoodle, Dansby James; and

4 WHEREAS, Cody Perez touched the lives of everyone around him
5 in ways beyond measure, and although he is profoundly missed, he
6 will forever hold a treasured place in their hearts; now,
7 therefore, be it
