- WHEREAS, Highly respected by her peers, Ms. McDermott has
- 23 served as chair of the American Alliance of Museums Accreditation
- 24 Commission; she has further given of her time and talents through

- 1 leadership roles with the San Antonio Convention and Visitors
- 2 Bureau, the Luminaria Contemporary Arts Festival, and the Alamo
- 3 Plaza Advisory Committee; over the years, she has received numerous
- 4 accolades, including the Jack Nokes Outstanding Service Award from
- 5 the Texas Association of Museums, the Business Person of the Year
- 6 award from the San Antonio Business Journal, and the Texas Patriot
- 7 Award from the Daughters of the Republic of Texas; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Admired for her commitment to expanding access to
- 9 the cultural, natural, and historical heritage of Texas, Marise
- 10 McDermott has made significant contributions to advancing the
- 11 mission of the Witte Museum, and she may indeed reflect with pride
- 12 on a career well spent as she embarks on the next exciting chapter
