R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Octavio A. Trujillo served his country with great  
2 honor and distinction as a member of the United States military, and  
3 he is being recognized for his contributions at the 27th Annual San  
4 Elizario Veterans Day Celebration on November 11, 2023; and

5           WHEREAS, Originally celebrated as Armistice Day in  
6 recognition of the end of World War I, Veterans Day now honors all  
7 who have served in the armed forces, including the former members of  
8 the U.S. Army, Navy, Marine Corps, Air Force, Space Force, Coast  
9 Guard, and National Guard; by upholding America's foundational  
10 values of selflessness and sacrifice, they have helped ensure that  
11 our country's promise will endure for generations to come; and

12           WHEREAS, Answering his nation's call to duty, Octavio  
13 A. Trujillo joined the U.S. Air Force in 1966 and went on to  
14 complete his enlistment at the rank of senior airman E-4 in 1970;

17 A. Trujillo upheld the highest ideals of the U.S. armed forces  
18 during his years in uniform, and his fellow citizens owe him a
